## 7s [AUD] (to hear)

AUDIBLE	ABDEILU	to call n substitute play in football [v -D, -LING, -S]
AUDIBLY	ABDILUY	in way so as to be heard [adv]
AUDIENT	ADEINTU	one that hears (to perceive by the ear) [n -S]
AUDILES	ADEILSU	AUDILE, one whose mental imagery is chiefly auditory [n]
AUDINGS	ADGINSU	AUDING, the process of hearing, recognizing, and interpreting spoken language [n]
AUDISMS	ADIMSSU	AUDISM, anti-deaf discrimination [n]
AUDISTS	ADISSTU	AUDIST, one that engages in audism [n]
AUDITED	ADDEITU	AUDIT, to examine with intent to verify [v]
AUDITEE	ADEEITU	one that is audited [n -S]
AUDITOR	ADIORTU	one that audits (to examine with intent to verify) [n -S]

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## 8s [AUD] (to hear)

AUDIENCE	ACDEEINU	group of listeners or spectators [n -S]
AUDITING	ADGIINTU	AUDIT, to examine with intent to verify [v]
AUDITION	ADIINOTU	to give trial performance [v -ED, -ING, -S]
AUDITIVE	ADEIITUV	auditory (group of listeners) [n -S]
AUDITORY	ADIORTUY	group of listeners [n -RIES]
PREAUDIT	ADEIPRTU	audit made prior to final settlement of transaction [n -S]
