ARTIFICE	ACEFIIRT	clever stratagem [n -S]
BENEFIC	BCEEFIN	kindly (kind (having gentle, giving nature)) [adj]
BENEFIT	BEEFINT	to be helpful or useful to [v -ED, -ING, -S, --TED, -TTING]
DEFEATS	ADEEFST	DEFEAT, to win victory over [v]
EDIFICE	CDEEFII	building (something that is built) [n -S]
FEATURE	AEEFRTU	to give special prominence to [v -D, -S, -RING]
FEIGNED	DEEFGIN	FEIGN, to pretend (to assume or display false appearance of) [v]
FEIGNER	EEFGINR	one that feigns (to pretend (to assume or display false appearance of)) [n -S]
FEATEST	AEEFSTT	FEAT, skillful (having skill (ability to do something well)) [adj]
FICTILE	CEFIILT	moldable (to work into particular shape) [adj]
FICTION	CFIINOT	literary work whose content is produced by imagination [n -S]
FICTIVE	CEFIITV	imaginary [adj]
FITMENT	EFIMNTT	equipment [n -S]
FITTING	FGIINTT	small often accessory part [n -S]
SUFFICE	CEFFISU	to be adequate [v -D, -S, -CING]

8s [FIC] & [FEIGN] & [FAIN] & [FIT] & [FEAT] (shape, make, fashion)

BENEFICE	BCEEEFIN	to endow with land [v -D, -S, -CING]
DEFEATED	ADDEEEFT	DEFEAT, to win victory over [v]
DEFEATER	ADEEEFRT	one that defeats (to win victory over) [n -S]
FEATLIER	AEEFILRT	FEATLY, graceful (having beauty of form or movement) [adj]
FEIGNING	EFGGIINN	FEIGN, to pretend (to assume or display false appearance of) [v]
REDEFEAT	ADEEEFRT	to defeat again [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SUFFICER	CEFFIRSU	one that suffices (to be adequate) [n -S]
