7s [GAM] (marriage)

AGAMETE	AAEEGMT	asexual reproductive cell [n -S]
AGAMOUS	AAGMOSU	agamic (asexual (occurring or performed without sexual action)) [adj]
APOGAMY	AAGMOPY	form of plant reproduction [n -MIES]
EXOLOGY	AEGMOXY	marriage outside of particular group [n -MIES]
GAMETAL	AAEGLMT	GAMETE, mature reproductive cell [adj]
GAMETES	AEEGMST	GAMETE, mature reproductive cell [n]
GAMETIC	ACEGIMT	GAMETE, mature reproductive cell [adj]
ISOGAMY	AGIMOSY	fusion of two similar gametes [n -MIES]
SYNGAMY	AGMNSYY	union of two gametes [n -MIES]
TRIGAMY	AGIMRTY	crime of being married to three people at once [n -MIES]

8s [GAM] (marriage)

ALLOGAMY	AAGLLMOY	fertilization of flower by pollen from another [n -MIES]
APOGAMIC	AACGIMOP	APOGAMY, form of plant reproduction [adj]
AUTOGAMY	AAGMOTUY	fertilization of flower by its own pollen [n -MIES]
BIGAMIES	ABEGIIMS	BIGAMY, crime of being married to two people at once [n]
BIGAMIST	ABGIIMST	one who commits bigamy (crime of being married to two people at once) [n -S]
BIGAMOUS	ABGIMOSU	guilty of bigamy [adj]
DIGAMIES	ADEGIIMS	DIGAMY, second legal marriage [n]
DIGAMIST	ADGIIMST	one who practices digamy (second legal marriage) [n -S]
DIGAMOUS	ADGIMOSU	DIGAMY, second legal marriage [adj]
ENDOGAMY	ADEGMNOY	marriage within particular group [n -MIES]
EXOAMIC	ACEGIMOX	EXOLOGY, marriage outside of particular group [adj]
GAMODEME	ADEEGMMO	somewhat isolated breeding community of organisms [n -S]
HOLOGY	AGHLMOOY	state of having gametes of same size and form as other cells [n -MIES]
HOMOGAMY	AGHMMOOY	bearing of sexually similar flowers [n -MIES]
MISOGAMY	AGIMMOSY	hatred of marriage [n -MIES]
MONOGAMY	AGMMNOOY	marriage with one person at time [n -MIES]
OOGAMETE	AEEGMOOT	female gamete of certain protozoa [n -S]
OOGAMIES	AEGIMOOS	OOGAMY, state of being oogamous (having structurally dissimilar gametes) [n]
OOGAMOUS	AGMOOOSU	having structurally dissimilar gametes [adj]
POLYGAMY	AGLMOPYY	condition of having more than one spouse at same time [n -MIES]
SYNGAMIC	ACGIMNSY	SYNGAMY, union of two gametes [adj]
XENOGAMY	AEGMNOXY	transfer of pollen from one plant to another [n -MIES]
