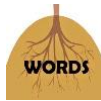

DIGRAPH	ADGHIPR	pair of letters representing single speech sound [n -S]
ENGRAFT	AIEFGNRT	to graft for propagation [v -ED, -ING, -S]
ENGRAMS	AIEGMNRS	ENGRAM, durable mark caused by stimulus upon protoplasm [n]
EPIGRAM	AIEGIMPR	brief, witty remark [n -S]

GRAFTING	AIEFGINRT	GRAFT, to unite with growing plant by insertion [v]
GRAMARYE	AAIEGMRRY	occult learning; magic [n -S]
GRAPHEME	AIEEGHMPR	unit of writing system [n -S]
GRAPHENE	AIEEGHNPR	sheet of carbon atoms [n -S]

LEXIGRAM	AEGILMRX	symbol representing word [n -S]
LIPOGRAM	AGILMOPR	writing in which certain letter of alphabet is omitted [n -S]
LOGOGRAM	AGGLMOOR	symbol used to represent entire word [n -S]
