APPLYING	AGILNPPY	APPLY, to bring into contact with something [v]
CROSSPLY	CLOPRSSY	having layers of fabric with cords lying crosswise in tire [adj]
EXPLICIT	CEIILPTX	statement formerly used at close of book [n -S]
IMPLICIT	CIIILMPT	implied [adj]
IMPLYING	GIILMNPY	IMPLY, to indicate or suggest indirectly [v]
MISAPPLY	AILMPPSY	to apply wrongly [v -LIED, -ING, -LIES]
MULTIPLY	ILLMPTUY	to increase in number [v -LIED, -ING, -LIES]
PLIANTLY	AILLNPTY	PLIANT, easily bent [adv]
PLICATED	ACDEILPT	plicate (pleated) [adj]
PLIOFILM	FIILLMOP	transparent sheet of chlorinated rubber used in packaging [n -S]
PLIOTRON	ILNOOPRT	type of vacuum tube [n -S]
PLYINGLY	GILLNPYY	PLY, to supply with or offer repeatedly [adv]
PREAPPLY	AELPPRY	to apply beforehand [v -LIED, -ING, -LIES]
REPLICON	CEILNOPR	section of nucleic* acid that replicates as unit [n -S]
REPLYING	EGILNPRY	REPLY, to answer (to say, write, or act in return) [v]
SEXTUPLY	ELPSTUXY	to six times as much or as many [adv]
UNPLIANT	AILNNPTU	not pliant (easily bent) [adj]
