EXPORTS	EOPRSTX	EXPORT, to send to other countries for commercial purposes [v]
IMPORTS	IMOPRST	IMPORT, to bring into country from abroad [v]
PORTAGE	AEGOPRT	to transport from one navigable waterway to another [v -D, -GING, -S]
PORTERS	EOPRRST	PORTER, to carry luggage for pay [v]
PURPORT	OPPRRTU	to profess or claim [v -ED, -ING, -S]
RAPPORT	AOPPRRT	harmonious relationship [n -S]
REPORTS	EOPRRST	REPORT, to give account of [v]
SPORTED	DEOPRST	SPORT, to frolic (to play and run about merrily) [v]
SPORTER	EOPRRST	one that sports (to frolic (to play and run about merrily)) [n -S]
SPORTIF	FIOPRST	person who is active or interested in physical competitions [n -S]
SUPPORT	OPPRSTU	to hold up or add strength to [v -ED, -ING, -S]

8s [PORT] (carry)

DEPORTED	DDEEOPRT	DEPORT, to expel from country [v]
DEPORTEE	DEEEOPRT	one who is deported [n -S]
DEPORTER	DEEOPRRT	one that departs (to expel from country) [n -S]
EXPORTED	DEEOPRXT	EXPORT, to send to other countries for commercial purposes [v]
EXPORTER	EEOPRRTX	one that exports (to send to other countries for commercial purposes) [n -S]
IMPORTED	DEIMOPRT	IMPORT, to bring into country from abroad [v]
IMPORTER	EIMOPRRT	one that imports (to bring into country from abroad) [n -S]
PORTABLE	ABELOPRT	something that can be carried [n -S]
PORTABLY	ABLOPRTY	so as to be capable of being carried [adv]
PORTANCE	ACENOPRT	demeanor (manner in which one conducts oneself) [n -S]
PORTERED	DEEOPRRT	PORTER, to carry luggage for pay [v]
REEXPORT	EEOPRRTX	to export again [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REIMPORT	EIMOPRRT	to import again [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REPORTED	DEEOPRRT	REPORT, to give account of [v]
REPORTER	EEOPRRRT	one that reports (to give account of) [n -S]
SPORTFUL	FLOPRSTU	sportive (playful (frolicsome)) [adj]
SPORTIER	EIOPRRST	SPORTY, showy (making great or brilliant display) [adj]
SPORTILY	ILOPRSTY	SPORTY, showy (making great or brilliant display) [adv]
SPORTING	GINOPRST	SPORT, to frolic (to play and run about merrily) [v]
SPORTIVE	EIOPRSTV	playful (frolicsome) [adj]
TELEPORT	EELOPRRT	to transport by process that involves no physical means [v -ED, -ING, -S]
