Put down **WORD [ROOTS]** (most basic form able to convey particular description, thought, meaning; not prefixes or suffixes) on your Scrabble board (7s then 8s)!

## 7s [SERV] (save, serve, keep)

DESERVE	DEEERSV	to be entitled to or worthy of [v -D, -S, -VING]
OBSERVE	BEEORSV	to look attentively [v -D, -S, -VING]
RESERVE	EEERSSV	to keep back for future use [v -D, -S, -VING]
SERVANT	AENRSTV	one that serves others [n -S]
SERVERS	EERRSSV	SERVER, one that serves another [n]
SERVERY	EERRSVY	counter or room from which meals are served [n -RIES]
SERVICE	CEEIRSV	to repair (to restore to good condition) [v -D, -S, -CING]
SERVILE	EEILRSV	slavishly submissive [adj]
SERVING	EGINRSV	portion of food [n -S] / SERVE, to work for [v]

## 8s [SERV] (save, serve, keep)

CONSERVE	CEENORSV	to protect from loss or depletion [v -D, -S, -VING]
DESERVER	DEEERRSV	one that deserves (to be entitled to or worthy of) [n -S]
DISSERVE	DEEIRSSV	to treat badly [v -D, -S, -VING]
LISTSERV	EILRSSTV	email system that automatically sends messages to all subscribers [n -S]
OBSERVER	BEEORRSV	one that observes (to look attentively) [n -S]
OUTSERVE	EEORSTUV	to surpass in serving [v -D, -S, -VING]
PRESERVE	EEEPRSSV	to keep free from harm or danger [v -D, -S, -VING]
RESERVER	EEERRRSV	one that reserves (to keep back for future use) [n -S]
SERVABLE	ABEELRSV	capable of serving or being served [adj]
SERVICER	CEEIRRSV	one that services (to repair (to restore to good condition)) [n -S]
SERVITOR	EIORRSTV	male servant [n -S]
SUBSERVE	BEERSSUV	to serve to promote [v -D, -S, -VING]
UNSERVED	DEENRSUV	not served (to work for) [adj]
