| RETINUE | EEINRTU | group of attendants [n -S] |
| SUSTAIN | AINSSTU | to maintain by providing with food and drink [v -ED, -ING, -S] |
| TENABLE | ABEELNT | capable of being held [adj] |
| TENABLELY | ABELNTY | TENABLE, capable of being held [adv] |
| TENAILS | AEILNST | TENAIL, tenaille (outer defense) [n] |
| TENANCY | ACENNTY | temporary occupancy of something that belongs to another [n -CIES] |
| TENANTS | AENNSTT | TENANT, to inhabit (to live in) [v] |
| TENDERS | DEENRST | TENDER, to present for acceptance [v] |
| TENDING | DEGINNT | TEND, to be disposed or inclined [v] |
| TENONED | DEENNOT | TENON, to unite by means of tenon (projection on end of piece of wood) [v] |
| TENONER | EENNORT | one that tenons (to unite by means of tenon (projection on end of piece of wood)) [n -S] |
| TENOURS | ENORSTU | TENOUR, tenor (high male singing voice) [n] |
| TENURED | DEENRTU | TENURE, to grant tenure (status of holding one's position on permanent basis) to [v] |
| TENURES | EENRSTU | TENURE, to grant tenure (status of holding one's position on permanent basis) to [v] |
| TENUTOS | ENOSTTU | TENUTO, musical note or chord held longer than its normal duration [n] |

| TENANTRY | AENNRTTY | tenancy (temporary occupancy of something that belongs to another) [n RIES] |
| TENDERED | DDEEENRT | TENDER, to present for acceptance [v] |

| TENDERLY | DEELNRTY | in tender (soft or delicate) manner [adv] |
