REUNIFY	EFINRUY	to unify again [v -FIED, -FIES, -ING]
REUNION	EINNORU	reuniting of persons after separation [n -S]
REUNITE	EEINRTU	to unite again [v -D, -S, -TING]
SUBUNIT	BINSTUU	unit that is part of larger unit [n -S]
UNIBODY	BDINOUY	single molded unit that forms bodywork and chassis of vehicle [n -DIES]
UNIBROW	BINORUW	single continuous eyebrow formed when hair grows above bridge of nose [n -S]
UNICOMS	CIMNOSU	UNICOM, radio communications system at some airports [n]
UNICORN	CINNORU	mythical horselike creature [n -S]
UNIFACE	ACEFINU	coin having design on only one side [n -S]
UNIFIED	DEFIINU	UNIFY, to make into coherent whole [v]
UNIFIER	EFIINRU	one that unifies (to make into coherent whole) [n -S]
UNIFIES	EFIINSU	UNIFY, to make into coherent whole [v]
UNIFORM	FIMNORU	unchanging (not changing (to make different)) [adj -ER, -EST] / to make uniform [v -ED, -ING, -S]
UNIPODS	DINOPSU	UNIPOD, one-legged support [n]
UNIQUER	EINQRUU	UNIQUE, existing as only one of its kind; very unusual [adj]
UNIQUES	EINQSUU	UNIQUE, something that is unique [n]
UNISIZE	EIINSUZ	made to fit all sizes [adj]
UNISONS	INNOSSU	UNISON, complete agreement [n]
UNITAGE	AEGINTU	amount in units [n -S]
UNITARD	ADINRTU	leotard that also covers legs [n -S]
UNITARY	AINRTUY	pertaining to unit (specific quantity used as standard of measurement) [adj]
UNITERS	EINRSTU	UNITER, one that unites (to bring together so as to form whole) [n]
UNITIES	EIINSTU	UNITY, state of being one single entity [n]
UNITING	GIINNTU	UNITE, to bring together so as to form whole [v]
UNITIVE	EIINTUV	serving to unite [adj]
UNITIZE	EIINTUZ	to divide into units [v -D, -S, -ZING]

BIUNIQUE	BEIINQUU	being type of correspondence between two sets [adj]
DISUNION	DIINNOSU	state of being disunited [n -S]
DISUNITE	DEIINSTU	to separate (to set or keep apart) [v -D, -S, -TING]
DISUNITY	DIINSTUY	lack of unity [n -TIES]
MISUNION	IIMNNOSU	bad union [n -S]
NONUNION	INNNNOOU	failure of broken bone to heal [n -S]
PREUNION	EINNOPRU	union beforehand [n -S]
PREUNITE	EEINPRTU	to unite beforehand [v -D, -S, -TING]
PROUNION	INNOOPRU	favoring labor unions [adj]
REUNITER	EEINRRTU	one that reunites (to unite again) [n -S]
UNIALGAL	AAGILLNU	pertaining to single algal cell [adj]
UNIAXIAL	AAIILNUX	having one axis [adj]
UNICOLOR	CILNOORU	of one color [adj]
UNICYCLE	CCEILNUY	to ride one-wheeled vehicle [v -D, -S, -LING]
UNIFILAR	AFIILNRU	having only one thread, wire, or fiber [adj]

UNILOBED	BDEILNOU	having one lobe [adj]
UNIMODAL	ADILMNOU	having or involving one mode [adj]
UNIONISE	EIINNOSU	to unionize (to form into union) [v -D, -S, -SING]
UNIONISM	IIMNNOSU	principle of forming union [n UNIONISMS]
UNIONIST	IINNOSTU	advocate of unionism [n -S]
UNIONIZE	EIINNOUZ	to form into union [v -D, -S, -ZING]
UNIPOLAR	AILNOPRU	showing only one kind of polarity [adj]
UNIQUELY	EILNQUUY	UNIQUE, existing as only one of its kind; very unusual [adv]
UNIQUEST	EINQSTUU	UNIQUE, existing as only one of its kind; very unusual [adj]
UNISEXES	EEINSSUX	UNISEX, condition of not being distinguishable as to sex [n]
UNISONAL	AILNNOSU	UNISON, complete agreement [adj]
UNITEDLY	DEILNTUY	UNITE, to bring together so as to form whole [adv]
UNITIZER	EIINRTUZ	one that unitizes (to divide into units) [n -S]
UNITRUST	INRSTTUU	type of annuity trust [n -S]
UNIVALVE	AEILNUVV	mollusk having single shell [n -S]
UNIVERSE	EEINRSUV	totality of all existing things [n -S]
UNIVOCAL	ACILNOUV	word having only one meaning [n -S]
