## 7s [VAC] (empty)

AIRVACS	AACIRSV	AIRVAC, evacuation by air ambulance [n]
EVACUEE	ACEEEUV	one that is evacuated [n -S]
MEDEVAC	ACDEEMV	to evacuate wounded from battlefield by helicopter [v -ED, -ING, -KED, -KING, -S]
MEDIVAC	ACDEIMV	medevac (to evacuate wounded from battlefield by helicopter) [v -ED, -ING, -KED, -KING, -S]
VACANCY	AACCNVY	quality or state of being vacant [n -CIES]
VACATED	AACDETV	VACATE, to make vacant [v]
VACATES	AACESTV	VACATE, to make vacant [v]
VACUITY	ACITUVY	empty space [n -TIES]
VACUOLE	ACELOUV	small cavity in organic tissue [n -S]
VACUOUS	ACOSUUV	empty (containing nothing (absence of all quantity or magnitude)) [adj]
VACUUMS	ACMSUUV	VACUUM, space entirely devoid of matter [n] / VACUUM, to use device that cleans by suction [v]

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## 8s [VAC] (empty)

EVACUANT	AACENTUV	cathartic medicine [n -S]
EVACUATE	AACEETUV	to remove from dangerous area [v -D, -S, -TING]
VACANTLY	AACLNTVY	VACANT, empty (containing nothing (absence of all quantity or magnitude)) [adv]
VACATING	AACGINTV	VACATE, to make vacant [v]
VACATION	AACINOTV	to take vacation (period of time devoted to rest and relaxation) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
VACUOLAR	AACLORUV	VACUOLE, small cavity in organic tissue [adj]
VACUUMED	ACDEMUVV	VACUUM, to use device that cleans by suction [v]
