REVALUE	AEELRUV	to value again [v -D, -UING, -S]
VALENCE	ACEELNV	degree of combining power of element or radical [n -S]
VALENCY	ACELNVY	valence (degree of combining power of element or radical) [n -CIES]
VALERIC	ACEILRV	VALERIAN, perennial herb [adj]
VALIANT	AAILNTV	courageous person [n -S]
VALIDLY	ADILLVY	in valid (based on evidence that can be supported) manner [adv]
VALINES	AEILNSV	VALINE, amino acid [n]

VALUING	AGILNUV	VALUE, to estimate value (quality that renders thing useful or desirable) of [v]
VALUTAS	AALSTUV	VALUTA, agreed or exchange value of currency [n]

BIVALENT	ABEILNTV	pair of chromosomes [n -S]
COVALENT	ACELNOTV	sharing electron pairs [adj]
DISVALUE	ADEILSUV	to treat as of little value [v -D, -UING, -S]
DIVALENT	ADEILNTV	having valence of two [adj]
EVALUATE	AAEELTUV	to determine value of [v -D, -S, -TING]
MISVALUE	AEILMSUV	to value (to estimate value (quality that renders thing useful or desirable) of) incorrectly [v -D, -UING, -S]
NONVALID	ADILNNOV	not valid (based on evidence that can be supported) [adj]
OUTVALUE	AELOTUUV	to be worth more than [v -D, -UING, -S]
PREVALUE	AEELPRUV	to value beforehand [v -D, -UING, -S]
UNVALUED	ADELNUUV	not valued (to estimate value (quality that renders thing useful or desirable) of) [adj]
VALENCIA	AACEILNV	woven fabric [n -S]
VALERATE	AAEELRTV	chemical salt [n -S]
VALERIAN	AAEILNRV	perennial herb [n -S]
VALIANCE	AACEILNV	valor (courage (quality that enables one to face danger fearlessly; spirit)) [n -S]
VALIANCY	AACILNVY	valor (courage (quality that enables one to face danger fearlessly; spirit)) [n -CIES]
VALIDATE	AADEILTV	to give legal force to [v -D, -TING, -S]
