ADVENTS	ADENSTV	ADVENT, arrival (act of arriving (to reach destination)) [n]
AVENUES	AEENSUV	AVENUE, wide street [n]
CONVENE	CEENNOV	to assemble (to come or bring together) [v -D, -NING, -S]
CONVENT	CENNOTV	to convene (to assemble (to come or bring together)) [v -D, -TING, -S]
EVENTER	EEENRTV	horse or rider competing in eventing [n -S]
INVENTS	EINNSTV	INVENT, to devise originally [v]
PARVENU	AENPRUV	one who has suddenly risen above his class [n -S]
PREVENT	EENPRTV	to keep from happening [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REVENUE	EEENRUV	income of government [n -S]
SUBVENE	BEENSUV	to arrive or occur as support or relief [v -D, -NING, -S]
VENIRES	EEINRSV	VENIRE, type of judicial writ [n]

CONVENER	CEENNORV	one that convenes (to assemble (to come or bring together)) [n -S]
CONVENOR	CENNOORV	convener (one that convenes (to assemble)) [n -S]
COVENANT	ACENNOTV	to enter into binding agreement [v -ED, -ING, -S]
EVENTFUL	EEFLNTUV	momentous [adj]
EVENTING	EEGINNTV	equestrian competition [n -S]
EVENTIVE	EEEINTVV	denoting event (something that occurs (to take place)) [adj]
EVENTUAL	AEELNTUV	occurring at later time [adj]
INVENTED	DEEINNTV	INVENT, to devise originally [v]
INVENTER	EEINNRTV	inventor (one that invents (to devise originally)) [n -S]
INVENTOR	EINNORTV	one that invents (to devise originally) [n -S]
MISEVENT	EEIMNSTV	mishap (unfortunate accident) [n -S]
NONEVENT	EENNNOTV	expected event that does not occur [n -S]
PARVENUE	AEENPRUV	woman who is parvenu [n -S]
REINVENT	EEINNRTV	to invent again [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REVENANT	AEENNRTV	one that returns (to come or go back) [n -S]
