7s [VER] & [VERI] (true, genuine)

AVERRED	ADEERRV	AVER, to declare positively [v]
VERDICT	CDEIRTV	decision at end of legal proceeding [n -S]
VERIDIC	CDEIIRV	truthful (telling truth (conformity to fact or reality)) [adj]
VERIEST	EEIRSTV	VERY, absolute (free from restriction) [adj]
VERISMO	EIMORSV	verism (realism in art or literature) [n -S]
VERISMS	EIMRSSV	VERISM, realism in art or literature [n]
VERISTS	EIRSSTV	VERIST, one who practices verism (realism in art or literature) [n]
VERITAS	AEIRSTV	truth (conformity to fact or reality) [n -ATES]
VERITES	EEIRSTV	VERITE, technique of filming so as to convey candid realism [n]

8s [VER] & [VERI] (true, genuine)

AVERMENT	AEEMNRTV	act of averring (to declare positively) [n -S]
AVERRING	AEGINRRV	AVER, to declare positively [v]
INVERTY	EIINRTVY	lack of truth [n -TIES]
REVERIFY	EEFIRRVY	to verify again [v -FIED, -FIES, -ING]
VERIFIED	DEEFIIRV	VERIFY, to prove to be true [v]
VERIFIER	EEFIIRRV	one that verifies (to prove to be true) [n -S]
VERIFIES	EEFIIRSV	VERIFY, to prove to be true [v]
VERISTIC	CEIIRSTV	VERISM, realism in art or literature [adj]
VERITIES	EEIIRSTV	VERITY, truth (conformity to fact or reality) [n]
