7s [VICT] & [VINC] (conquer)

CONVICT	CCINOTV	to prove guilty [v -ED, -ING, -S]
EVICTED	CDEEITV	EVICT, to expel by legal process [v]
EVICTEE	CEEEITV	one that is evicted [n -S]
EVICTOR	CEIORTV	one that evicts (to expel by legal process) [n -S]
EVINCED	CDEEINV	EVINCE, to show clearly [v]
EVINCES	CEEINSV	EVINCE, to show clearly [v]
VICTORS	CIORSTV	VICTOR, one who defeats adversary (opponent (one that opposes another)) [n]
VICTORY	CIORTVY	successful outcome in contest or struggle [n -RIES]

8s [VICT] & [VINC] (conquer)

CONVINCE	CCEINNOV	to cause to believe something [v -D, -S, -CING]
EVICTING	CEGIINTV	EVICT, to expel by legal process [v]
EVICTION	CEIINOTV	act of evicting (to expel by legal process) [n -S]
EVINCING	CEGIINNV	EVINCE, to show clearly [v]
EVINCIVE	CEEIINVV	EVINCE, to show clearly [adj]
VICTORIA	ACIIORTV	light carriage [n -S]
VICTRESS	CEIRSSTV	female victor [n -ES]
VINCIBLE	BCEIILNV	capable of being conquered [adj]
VINCIBLY	BCIILNVY	VINCIBLE, capable of being conquered [adv]
