REVIVER	EEIRRVV	one that revives (to bring back to life or consciousness) [n -S]
REVIVES	EEIRSVV	REVIVE, to bring back to life or consciousness [v]
SURVIVE	EIRSUVV	to remain in existence [v -D, -S, -ING]
VITALLY	AILLTVY	in vital (necessary to life) manner [adv]
VITAMER	AEIMRTV	type of chemical compound [n -S]
VITAMIN	AIIMNTV	any of various organic substances essential to proper nutrition [n -S]
VIVACES	ACEISVV	VIVACE, musical passage played in brisk spirited manner [n]
VIVERID	DEIIRVV	mammalian family [n -S]
VIVIDER	DEIIRVV	VIVID, strikingly bright or intense [adj]
VIVIDLY	DIILVVY	VIVID, strikingly bright or intense [adv]
VIVIFIC	CFIIVV	vivifying [adj]

SURVIVAL	AILRSUVV	living or continuing longer than another person or thing [n -S]
SURVIVER	EIRRSUVV	survivor (one that survives (to remain in existence)) [n -S]
SURVIVOR	IORRSUVV	one that survives (to remain in existence) [n -S]
VITALISE	AEIILSTV	to vitalize (to give life to) [v -D, -S, -SING]
VITALISM	AIILMSTV	philosophical doctrine [n -S]
VITALIST	AIILSTTV	advocate of vitalism [n -S]
VITALITY	AIILTTVY	exuberant physical strength or mental vigor [n -TIES]
VITALIZE	AEIILTVZ	to give life to [v VITALIZED, VITALIZES, VITALIZING]
VITAMINE	AEIIMNTV	vitamin (any of various organic substances essential to proper nutrition) [n -S]
VIVACITY	ACIITVVY	quality or state of being lively [n -TIES]
VIVARIES	AEIIRSVV	VIVARY, vivarium (place for raising and keeping live animals) [n]
VIVARIUM	AIIMRUVV	place for raising and keeping live animals [n -IA, -S]
VIVERRID	DEIIRRVV	any of family of small carnivorous mammals [n -S]
VIVIDEST	DEIISTVV	VIVID, strikingly bright or intense [adj]
VIVIFIED	DEFIIVV	VIVIFY, to give life to [v]
VIVIFIER	EFIIRVV	one that vivifies (to give life to) [n -S]
VIVIFIES	EFIISVV	VIVIFY, to give life to [v]
VIVIPARA	AAIIPRVV	animals that bring forth living young [n VIVIPARA]
