7s -CUT(S) (v. to divide into parts with sharp-edge instrument)

BUZZCUT	BCTUUZZ	very short haircut [n -S]
CREWCUT	CCERTUW	short haircut [n -S]
HAIRCUT	ACHIRTU	cutting of hair [n -S]
LINECUT	CEILNTU	type of printing plate [n -S]
LINOCUT	CILNOTU	print made from design cut into linoleum [n -S]
OFFCUTS	CFFOSTU	OFFCUT, something that is cut off [n]
OVERCUT	CEORTUV	to cut too much [v OVERCUT, -S, -TTING]
WOODCUT	CDOOTUW	engraved block of wood [n -S]

8s -CUT(S) (v. to divide into parts with sharp-edge instrument)

CLEARCUT	ACCELRTU	to cut forest completely [v CLEARCUT, -S, -TTING]
CROSSCUT	CCORSSTU	to cut across [v CROSSCUT, -S, -TTING]
SHORTCUT	CHORSTTU	to take shorter or quicker way [v SHORTCUT, -S, -TTING]
STONECUT	CENOSTTU	print made from image engraved on stone [n -S]
UNDERCUT	CDENRTUU	to cut under [v UNDERCUT, -S, -TTING]
UPPERCUT	CEPPRTUU	to strike upward blow [v UPPERCUT, -S, -TTING]
