



From Start to Finish- Suffix

Less common suffixes – see **All's Well That Ends Well** for common suffixes

7s -EER (meaning = engaged in something; associated with something)

PIONEER EEINOPR to take part in beginnings of [v -ED, -ING, -S]

8s -EER (meaning = engaged in something; associated with something)

CAMELEER ACEEELMR camel driver [n -S]
DOMINEER DEEIMNOR to tyrannize [v -ED, -ING, -S]
ENGINEER EEEGINNR to carry through or manage by contrivance [v -ED, -ING, -S]
FUSILEER EEFILRSU fusilier (soldier armed with fusil) [n -S]
MULETEER EEELMRTU one who drives mules (hoofed work animals) [n -S]
MUTINEER EEIMNRTU to mutiny (to revolt against constituted authority) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
