BLACKEN	ABCEKLN	to make black (being of darkest color) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
BROADEN	ABDENOR	to make broad (wide (having great extent from side to side)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
BURTHEN	BEHNRTU	to burden (to load heavily) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
CHASTEN	ACEHNST	to chastise (to discipline by punishment) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
CHEAPEN	ACEEHNP	to make cheap (inexpensive) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
CHICKEN	CCEHIKN	to lose one's nerve [v -ED, -ING, -S]

GLADDEN	ADDEGLN	to make glad (feeling pleasure) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
GLISTEN	EGILNST	to shine by reflection [v -ED, -ING, -S]
GREATEN	AEEGNRT	to make greater (large (of considerable size or quantity)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
HARSHEN	AEHHNRS	to make harsh (severe (unsparing in treatment of others)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
HEARKEN	AEEHKNR	to listen to [v -ED, -ING, -S]
HEARTEN	AEEHNRT	to give courage to [v -ED, -ING, -S]
HOARSEN	AEHNORS	to make hoarse (low and rough in sound) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
LIGHTEN	EGHILNT	to reduce weight of [v -ED, -ING, -S]
MOISTEN	EIMNOST	to make or become moist [v -ED, -ING, -S]
PLUMPEN	ELMNPPU	to plump (to make plump) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
QUICKEN	CEIKNQU	to speed up [v -ED, -ING, -S]
QUIETEN	EEINQTU	to quiet (to cause to be quiet) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REWAKEN	AEEKNRW	WAKEN, to wake (to rouse from sleep) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REWIDEN	DEEINRW	WIDEN, to make wide or wider [v -ED, -ING, -S]
ROUGHEN	EGHNORU	to make rough (having uneven surface) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SHARPEN	AEHNPRS	to make sharp (suitable for or capable of cutting or piercing) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SHORTEN	EHNORST	to make or become shorter [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SLACKEN	ACEKLNS	to make less tight or taut [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SLEEKEN	EEEKLNS	to sleek (to make sleek) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SLICKEN	CEIKLNS	to make slick (smooth and slippery) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SLIDDEN	DDEILNS	SLIDE, to move smoothly along surface [v]
SMARTEN	AEMNRST	to improve in appearance [v -ED, -ING, -S]
STEEPEN	EEENPST	to make steep (inclined sharply) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
STIFFEN	EFFINST	to make stiff (difficult to bend or stretch) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SWEETEN	EEENSTW	to make sweet (pleasing to taste) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
THICKEN	CEHIKNT	to make thick (having relatively great extent from one surface to its opposite) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
TIGHTEN	EGHINTT	to make tight (firmly or closely fixed in place) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
TOUGHEN	EGHNOTU	to make tough (strong and resilient) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
YOUTHEN	EHNOTUY	to make youthful (young (being in early period of life or growth)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]

## 8s -EN (meaning = [verb] become)

BEDARKEN	ABDEEKNR	to darken (to make dark (having little or no light)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
BEDAUFEN	ABDEEEFN	to deafen (to make deaf (lacking sense of hearing)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
BEMADDEN	ABDDEEMN	to madden (to make or become mad) [v -ED, -ING, -S]

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BESCREEN	BCEENRS	to screen (to provide with screen (device designed to divide, conceal, or protect)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
BRIGHTEN	BEGHINRT	to make bright (emitting much light) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
CHRISTEN	CEHINRST	to baptize (to administer baptism to) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
EMBIGGEN	BEEGGIMN	to make bigger [v -ED, -ING, -S]
EMBOLDEN	BDEELMNO	to instill with courage [v -ED, -ING, -S]
FRIGHTEN	EFGHINRT	to make afraid (filled with apprehension) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
HEIGHTEN	EEGHHINT	to raise (to move to higher position) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
IMBOLDEN	BDEILMNO	to embolden (to instill with courage) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
LENGTHEN	EEGHLNNT	to make or become longer [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REAWAKEN	AAEEKNRW	AWAKEN, to awake (to wake up) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REFASTEN	AEEFNIRST	FASTEN, to secure (to make firm or tight) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
REHARDEN	ADEEHNRR	HARDEN, to make hard (firm and unyielding) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
RESCREEN	CEENRRS	SCREEN, to provide with screen (device designed to divide, conceal, or protect) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
RESOFTEN	EEFNORST	SOFTEN, to make soft (yielding readily to pressure) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SMOOTHEN	EHMNOOST	to smooth (to make smooth) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
STRAITEN	AEINRSTT	to make strait (narrow (of little width)) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
THREATEN	AEEHNRTT	to be source of danger to [v -ED, -ING, -S]
UNBURDEN	BDENNRUU	to free from burden [v -ED, -ING, -S]
UNFASTEN	AEFNNSTU	to release from fastenings [v -ED, -ING, -S]
UNHAPPEN	AEHNNPPU	to become as though never having happened [v -ED, -ING, -S]
UNLOOSEN	ELNNOOSU	to unloose (to set free) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
