KARSTIC	ACIKRST	KARST, a limestone region [adj]
OERSTED	DEEORST	a unit of magnetic intensity [n OERSTEDS]
THIRSTS	HIRSSTT	THIRST, to feel a desire or need to drink [v]
THIRSTY	HIRSTTY	feeling a desire or need to drink [adj THIRSTIER, THIRSTIEST]
VERSTES	EERSSTV	VERSTE, verst (a Russian measure of distance) [n]
WARSTLE	AELRSTW	to wrestle (to engage in a type of hand-to-hand contest) [v WARSTLED, WARSTLING, WARSTLES]
WORSTED	DEORSTW	a woolen yarn [n WORSTEDS] / WORST, to defeat (to win victory over) [v]
