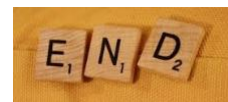


All's Well that Ends Well: -SOME

IRKSOME	EIKMORS	tending to irk [adj]
LISSOME	EILMOSS	lithe (bending easily) [adj]
NOISOME	EIMNOOS	disgusting; harmful [adj]
TWASOME	AEMOSTW	twosome (group of two) [n -S]

WAGSOME	AEGMOSW	waggish (playfully humorous) [adj]
WINSOME	EIMNOSW	charming (pleasing) [adj -R, -ST]

DARKSOME	ADEKMORS	dark (having little or no light) [adj]
DOLESOME	DEELMOOS	doleful (mournful (expressing grief or sorrow)) [adj]
FEARFUL	AEEFMORS	frightening [adj]
FOURSOME	EFMOORSU	group of four [n -S]
FRETSOME	EEFMORST	fretful (inclined to fret) [adj]
GAMESOME	AEEGMMOS	playful (frolicsome) [adj]
GLADSOME	ADEGLMOS	glad (feeling pleasure) [adj -R, -ST]
GLEESOME	EEEGLMOS	gleeful (merry (cheerful (full of spirits))) [adj]
GREWSOME	EEGMORSW	gruesome (repugnant) [adj -R, -ST]

HANDSOME	ADEHMNOS	attractive [adj -R, -ST]
