AIRTIME	AEIIMRT	time when broadcast begins [n -S]
ANYTIME	AEIMNTY	at any time [adv]
BEDTIME	BDEEIMT	time for going to bed [n -S]
BIGTIME	BEGIIMT	pertaining to highest level [adj]
DAYTIME	ADEIMTY	day (time between sunrise and sunset) [n -S]
ONETIME	EEIMNOT	former [adj]
RAGTIME	AEGIMRT	style of American dance music [n -S]
TEATIME	AEEIMTT	customary time for tea [n -S]
WARTIME	AEIMRTW	time of war [n -S]

CHOWTIME	CEHIMOTW	mealtime (usual time for meal) [n -S]
DOWNTIME	DEIMNOTW	time when machine or factory is inactive [n -S]
FLEXTIME	EEFILMTX	system that allows flexible working hours [n -S]
HALFTIME	AEFHILMT	intermission in football game [n -S]
LIFETIME	EEFIILMT	period of living existence [n -S]
LONGTIME	EGILMNOT	of long duration [adj]
MEALTIME	AEEILMMT	usual time for meal [n -S]
MEANTIME	AEEIMMNT	intervening time [n -S]
NOONTIME	EIMNNOOT	noon (midday (middle of day)) [n -S]
PLAYTIME	AEILMPTY	time for play or amusement [n -S]
SEEDTIME	DEEEIMST	season for sowing seeds [n -S]
SHIPTIME	EHIIMPST	annual arrival of supply ship [n -S]
SHOWTIME	EHIMOSTW	time at which entertainment is to start [n -S]
SOMETIME	EEIMMOST	at some future time [adv]
TERMTIME	EEIMMRTT	time when school or court is in session [n -S]
ZONETIME	EEIMNOTZ	standard time used at sea [n -S]
