AIRWARD	AADIRRW	toward sky [adv]
AWKWARD	AADKRWW	lacking skill, dexterity, or grace [adj -ER, -EST]
BEDWARD	ABDDERW	toward bed [adv]
FORWARD	ADFORRW	being at point in advance [adj -ER, -EST]
FROWARD	ADFORRW	disobedient [adj]
GODWARD	ADDGORW	toward God [adv]
LEeward	ADEELRW	direction toward which wind is blowing [n -S]
MANWARD	AADMNRW	toward man [adv]
OUTWARD	ADORTUW	toward outside [adv]
SEAWARD	AADERSW	direction toward open sea [n -S]
SKYWARD	ADKRSWY	toward sky [adv]
SUNWARD	ADNRSUW	toward sun [adv]
VANWARD	AADNRVW	toward front [adv]
WAYWARD	AADRWWY	willful (bent on having one's own way) [adj]

8s -WARD (adjective, adverb, and noun; (in direction or manner)

BACKWARD	AABCDKRW	toward back [adv]
CITYWARD	ACDIRTWY	toward city [adv]
DOWNWARD	ADDNORWW	from higher to lower place [adv]
EASTWARD	AADERSTW	direction toward east [n -S]
GOALWARD	AADGLORW	toward goal (point-scoring area) [adv]
HEADWARD	AADDEHRW	toward head [adj] / toward head [adv]
HELLWARD	ADEHLLRW	toward hell (place of great suffering)) [adv]
HOMEWARD	ADEHMORW	toward home [adv]
LAKeward	AADEKLRW	facing lake (sizable inland body of water) [adj]
LANDWARD	AADDLNRW	toward land [adv]
LEFTWARD	ADEFRLRW	toward left [adv]
MOONWARD	ADMNOORW	toward moon [adv]
POLEWARD	ADELOPRW	in direction of either extremity of earth's axis [adv]
REARWARD	AADERRRW	rearmost division of army [n -S]
REReward	ADEERRRW	rearward (rearmost division of army) [n -S]
SELFWARD	ADEFRLRW	toward oneself [adv]
SIDEWARD	ADDEIRSW	toward one side [adv]
TOWNWARD	ADNORTWW	toward town [adv]
UNTOWARD	ADNORTUW	unruly (difficult to control) [adj]
WESTWARD	ADERSTWW	direction toward west [n -S]
WINDWARD	ADDINRWW	direction from which wind blows [n -S]
