## 7s -WARE

BARWARE	AABERRW	barroom equipment [n -S]
NAGWARE	AAEGNRW	software that is at first free but often reminds user to pay for it [n -S]
REDWARE	ADEERRW	edible seaweed [n -S]
SEAWARE	AAEERSW	seaweed used as fertilizer [n -S]
SPYWARE	AEPRSWY	computer software by which personal information is covertly sent to another computer [n -S]
TEAWARE	AAEERTW	tea service [n -S]
TINWARE	AEINRTW	articles made of tinplate [n -S]
WETWARE	AEERTWW	human brain when considered as functionally equivalent to computer [n -S]

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## 8s -WARE

BAKEWARE	AABEEKRW	dishes used for baking [n -S]
CANEWARE	AACEENRW	yellowish stoneware [n -S]
CLAYWARE	AACELRWY	pottery (ware molded from clay and hardened by heat) [n -S]
COOKWARE	ACEKOORW	utensils used in cooking [n -S]
DISHWARE	ADEHIRSW	tableware used in serving food [n -S]
FIRMWARE	AEFIMRRW	computer programs permanently stored on microchip [n -S]
FLATWARE	AAEFLRTW	tableware that is fairly flat [n -S]
FREWARE	AEEEFRRW	software distributed without charge [n -S]
GIFTWARE	AEFGIRTW	wares suitable for gifts [n -S]
HARDWARE	AADEHRRW	metal goods [n -S]
IRONWARE	AEINORRW	articles made of iron [n -S]
LIVEWARE	AEEILRVW	working personnel [n -S]
OVENWARE	AEENORVW	heat-resistant dishes for baking and serving food [n -S]
SLIPWARE	AEILPRSW	type of pottery (ware molded from clay and hardened by heat) [n -S]
SOFTWARE	AEFORSTW	written or printed data used in computer operations [n -S]
STEMWARE	AEEMRSTW	type of glassware [n -S]
TOLEWARE	AEELORTW	objects made of elaborately decorated sheet metal [n -S]
