APOCARP	AACOPPR	fruit having separated carpels [n -S]
APOCOPE	ACEOOPP	omission of last sound of word [n -S]
APOGAMY	AAGMOPY	form of plant reproduction [n -MIES]
APOGEAL	AAEGLOP	APOGEE, point in orbit of body which is farthest from earth [adj]
APOGEAN	AAEGNOP	APOGEE, point in orbit of body which is farthest from earth [adj]
APOGEES	AEEGOPS	APOGEE, point in orbit of body which is farthest from earth [n]
APOGEIC	ACEGIOP	APOGEE, point in orbit of body which is farthest from earth [adj]
APOLOGS	AGLOOPS	APOLOG, apologue (allegory (story presenting a moral principle)) [n]
APOLOGY	AGLOOPY	expression of regret for some error or offense [n -GIES]
APOLUNE	AELNOPU	point in orbit of body which is farthest from moon [n -S]
APOMICT	ACIMOPT	organism produced by apomixis [n -S]
APOTHEM	AEHMOPT	perpendicular from center to any side of regular polygon [n -S]

APOCARPY	AACOPPRY	state of being apocarp (fruit having separated carpels) [n -PIES]

APOCRINE	ACEINOPR	pertaining to type of gland [adj]
APODOSIS	ADIOOPSS	main clause of conditional sentence [n -SES]
APOGAMIC	AACGIMOP	APOGAMY, form of plant reproduction [adj]
APOLOGAL	AAGLLOOP	pertaining to apologue (allegory (story presenting moral principle)) [adj]
APOLOGIA	AAGILOOP	formal justification or defense [n -E, -S]
APOLOGUE	AEGLOOPU	allegory (story presenting moral principle) [n -S]
APOMIXIS	AIIMOPSX	type of reproductive process [n -XES]
APOPHONY	AHNOOPPY	ablaut (patterned change in root vowels of verb forms) [n -NIES]
APOPHYGE	AEGHOPPY	concave curve in a column [n -S]
APOPLEXY	AELOPPXY	sudden loss of sensation and muscular control [n -XIES]
APOSPORY	AOOPRSY	type of reproduction without spore formation [n -RIES]
APOSTACY	AACOPSTY	apostasy (abandonment of one's faith or principles) [n -CIES]
APOSTASY	AAOPSSTY	abandonment of one's faith or principles [n -SIES]
APOSTATE	AAEOPSTT	one who commits apostasy (abandonment of one's faith or principles) [n -S]
APOTHECE	ACEEHOPT	spore-producing organ of certain fungi [n -S]
APOTHEGM	AEGHMOPT	maxim (brief statement of general truth or principle) [n -S]
