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| AEFILNRS | ALIGNERS | ALIGNER, one that aligns (to arrange in straight line) [n] |
| AEFILNRS | ENGRAILS | ENGRAIL, to ornament edge of with curved indentations [v] |
| AEFILNRS | LASERING | LASER, to treat with laser (device that amplifies light waves) [v] |
| AEFILNRS | NARGILES | NARGILE, narghile (hookah (water pipe)) [n] |
| AEFILNRS | REALIGNS | REALIGN, to align again [v] |
| AEFILNRS | SIGNALER | one that signals (to notify by means of communication) [n -S] |
| AEFILNRS | SLANGIER | SLANGY, being or containing slang [adj] |
| DEIOPRST | DIOPTERS | DIOPTER, measure of refractive power [n] |
| DEIOPRST | DIOPTRES | DIOPTRE, diopter (measure of refractive power) [n] |
| DEIOPRST | PERIDOTS | PERIDOT, mineral (naturally occurring inorganic substance having characteristic set of physical properties) [n] |
| DEIOPRST | PORTSIDE | on left side of ship facing forward [adv] |
| DEIOPRST | PROTEIDS | PROTEID, protein (nitrogenous organic compound) [n] |
| DEIOPRST | RIPOSTED | RIPOST, to riposte (to make return thrust in fencing) [v] / RIPOSTE [v] |
| DEIOPRST | TOPSIDER | one who is at highest level of authority [n -S] |
