BILAYER	ABEILRY	film with two molecular layers [n -S]

BILOBED	BBDEILO	bilobate (having two lobes) [adj]
BIMETAL	ABEILMT	something composed of two metals [n -S]

BIMORPH	BHIMOPR	device consisting of two crystals cemented together [n -S]
BINOCLE	BCEILNO	binocular [n -S]
