only nouns, VAMBRACE, VAMBRACES, and adjective, VAMBRACED; no -ING verb

VANDYKE ADEKNVY short, pointed beard

only nouns, VANDYKE, VANDYKES, and adjective, VANDYKED; no -ING verb





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VANITY AINTVY inflated pride in oneself

only nouns, VANITY, VANITIES, and adjective, VANITIED; no -ING verb

VARICOSE ACEIORSV abnormally swollen or dilated

only adjectives, VARICOSE, VARICOSED; no other forms

VELVET EELTVV soft, smooth fabric

only nouns, VELVET, VELVETS, and adjective, VELVETED; no -ING verb

VERANDA AADENRV type of porch (covered structure at entrance to building)

VERANDAH AADEHNRV veranda (type of porch (covered structure at entrance to building))

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WEASELY AEELSWY weaselly (resembling weasel (small carnivorous mammal))

adjective but does NOT compare

WOOL LOOW dense, soft hair forming coat of certain animals

WRETCH CEHRTW wretched (extremely unhappy) person

only nouns, WRETCH, WRETCHES, and adjective, WRETCHED, WRETCHEDER, WRETCHEDEST; no -ING verb

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YCLEPED CDEELPY yclept (called, named)

only adjectives, YCLEPED, YCLEPT; no other forms
