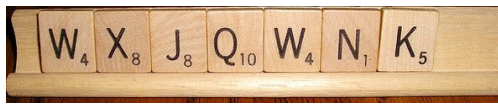

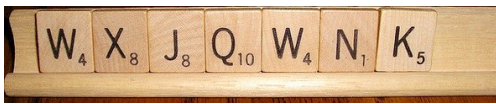
PHYLLARY AHLLPRYY bract of certain plants [n -RIES]
