| TENAILE | AEEILLNT | outer defense [n -S] |
| TOENAILS | AEILNOST | TOENAIL, to fasten with obliquely driven nails [v] |
| TREENAIL | AEEILNRT | wooden peg used for fastening timbers [n -S] |
| TRENAILS | AEILNRST | TRENAIL, treenail (wooden peg used for fastening timbers) [n] |
| UNNAILED | ADEILNNU | UNNAIL, to remove nails from [v] |
| ZENAIDAS | AADEINSZ | ZENAIDA, wild dove [n] |
