KAOLINIC	ACIIKLNO	KAOLIN, fine white clay [adj]
KARAOKE	AAEKKORS	KARAOKE, musical device to which user sings along [n]
MIAOUIING	AGIIMNOU	MIAOUI, to meow (to make crying sound of cat) [v]
MIAOWING	AGIIMNOW	MIAOW, to meow (to make crying sound of cat) [v]
PHARAOHS	AAHHOPRS	PHARAOH, ruler of ancient Egypt [n]
TAMARAOS	AAAMORST	TAMARAO, tamarau (small buffalo of Philippines) [n]
TERAOHMS	AEHMORST	TERAOHM, one trillion ohms [n]
