DUUMVIR	DIMRUUV	magistrate of ancient Rome [n -I, -S]
MUUMUUS	MMSUUUU	MUUMUU, long, loose dress [n]
TRIDUUM	DIMRTUU	period of three days of prayer [n -S]
VACUUMS	ACMSUUV	VACUUM, a space entirely devoid of matter [n] / VACUUM, to use a device that cleans by suction [v]

Ends with -UU
