FOOTBAG	ABFGOOT	small bag filled with pellets that is kept aloft with feet [n -S]
FOOTBED	BDEFBOOT	insole in boot or shoe [n -S]
FOOTBOY	BFOOOTY	serving boy [n -S]
FOOTMAN	AFMNOOT	male servant (one that serves others) [n -MEN]
FOOTPAD	ADFOOPT	one who robs pedestrian [n -S]
FOOTWAY	AFOOTWY	footpath (path for pedestrians) [n -S]

FOOTBALL	ABFLLOOT	type of ball [n -S]
FOOTBATH	ABFHOOTT	bath for feet [n -S]
FOOTFALL	AFFLLOOT	sound of footstep [n -S]
FOOTGEAR	AefGOORT	footwear (wearing apparel for feet) [n FOOTGEAR]
FOOTHILL	FHILLOOT	low hill at foot of higher hills [n -S]
FOOTHOLD	DFHLOOOT	secure support for feet [n -S]
FOOTLONG	FGLNOOOT	hot dog one foot long [n -S]
FOOTMARK	AFKMOORT	mark left by foot on surface [n -S]
FOOTNOTE	EFNOOOTT	to furnish with explanatory notes [v -D, -TING, -S]
FOOTPACE	ACEFOOPT	walking pace [n -S]
FOOTPATH	AFHOOPTT	path for pedestrians [n -S]
FOOTRACE	ACEFOORT	race run on foot [n -S]
FOOTREST	EFOORSTT	support for feet [n -S]
FOOTROPE	EFOOPRT	rope used in sailing [n -S]
FOOTSLOG	FGLOOOST	to march through mud [v -GGED, -GGING, -S]
FOOTSORE	EFOORST	having sore or tired feet [adj]
FOOTSTEP	EFOOPSTT	step with foot [n -S]
FOOTWALL	AFLLOOTW	layer of rock beneath vein of ore [n -S]
FOOTWEAR	AEFOORTW	wearing apparel for feet [n FOOTWEAR]
FOOTWELL	EFLLOOTW	space for feet in motor vehicle [n -S]
FOOTWORK	FKOOORTW	use of feet [n -S]
FOOTWORN	FNOOORTW	footsore (having sore or tired feet) [adj]
