FOLIAGE AEFGILO growth of leaves of plant [n -S]
FOLIOSE EFILOOS having leaves [adj]
FOLIOUS FILOOSU foliose (having leaves) [adj]
FRONDED DDEFNOR FROND, type of leaf (usually green, flattened organ of vascular plants) [adj]

RHIZOMA AHIMORZ rhizome (rootlike, underground stem) [n -TA]
RHIZOME EHIMORZ rootlike, underground stem [n -S]
ROOTAGE AEGOORT system of roots [n -S]
ROOTIER EIOORRT ROOTY, full of roots [adj]
ROOTING GINOORT ROOT, to put forth root (underground portion of plant) [v]
ROOTLET ELOORTT small root [n -S]

SPORING GINOPRS SPORE, to produce spores (asexual, usually single-celled reproductive bodies) [v]



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SPOROID DIOOPRS resembling spore [adj]
SPORULE ELOPRSU small spore [n -S]

TELOMIC CEILMOT TELOME, structural unit of vascular plant [adj]

FERNLIKE EEFIKLNK FERN, flowerless vascular plant [adj]

LEAVIEST AEEILSTV LEAVY, leafy (covered with leaves) [adj]
LUSHNESS EHLNSSSU state of being lush (abounding in vegetation) [n -ES]
