7s HYPO- & HYP- (below, less than normal)

HYPHENS	EHHNPSY	HYPHEN, to connect words or syllables with hyphen (mark of punctuation) [v]
HYPOING	GHINOPY	HYPO, to inject with hypodermic needle [v]
HYPONEA	AEHNOPY	hyponoia (dulled mental activity) [n -S]
HYPONYM	HMNOPYY	word that denotes subcategory [n -S]
HYPOXIA	AHIOPXY	deficiency of oxygen in body tissue [n -S]
HYPOXIC	CHIOPXY	HYPOXIA, deficiency of oxygen in body tissue [adj]

8s HYPO- & HYP- (below, less than normal)

HYPHEMIA	AEHHIMPY	deficiency of blood [n -S]
HYPHENED	DEEHHNPY	HYPHEN, to connect words or syllables with hyphen (mark of punctuation) [v]
HYPHENIC	CEHHINPY	HYPHEN, to connect words or syllables with hyphen (mark of punctuation) [adj]
HYPOACID	ACDHIOPY	having lower than normal degree of acidity [adj]
HYPODERM	DEHMOPRY	skin layer [n -S]
HYPOGEAL	AEGHLOPY	underground [adj]
HYPOGEAN	AEGHNOPY	hypogeal (underground) [adj]
HYPOGENE	EEGHNOPY	formed underground [adj]
HYPOGEUM	EGHMOPUY	underground chamber [n -S]
HYPOGYNY	GHNOPYYY	condition of having flowers with organs situated below ovary [n -NIES]
HYPONOIA	AHINOOPY	dulled mental activity [n -S]
HYPONYMY	HMNOPYYY	state of being hyponym (word that denotes subcategory) [n -MIES]
HYPOPNEA	AEHNOPPY	abnormally shallow breathing [n -S]
HYPOPYON	HNOOPPYY	accumulation of pus in eye [n -S]
