| SKUNKIER | EIKKNRSU | SKUNKY, having smell suggestive of skunk (mammal that can spray foul-smelling liquid) [adj] |
| SMELLIER | EEILLMRS | SMELLY, having unpleasant odor [adj] |
| SMELLING | EGILLMNS | SMELL, to perceive by means of olfactory nerves [v] |
| SMELTING | EGILMNST | SMELT, SMELL, to perceive by means of olfactory nerves [v] |
| STENCHES | CEEHNSST | STENCH, foul odor [n] |
| STINKBUG | BGIKNSTU | insect that emits foul odor [n -S] |
| STINKIER | EIIKNRST | STINKY, emitting foul odor [adj] |
| STINKING | GIIKNNST | STINK, to emit foul odor [v] |
| STINKPOT | IKNOPSTT | jar containing foul-smelling combustibles formerly used in warfare [n -S] |
