ANOSMIA	AAIMNOS	loss of sense of smell [n -S]

FOETORS	EFOORST	FOETOR, fetor (offensive odor) [n]
FOXFIRE	EFFIORX	glow produced by certain fungi on decaying wood [n -S]

FUGGIER	EFGGIRU	FUGGY, stuffy and odorous [adj]
FUGGILY	FGGILUY	FUGGY, stuffy and odorous [adv]

FUMETTE	EEFMTTU	fumet (odor of meat while cooking) [n -S]

MAYWEED	ADEEMWY	malodorous weed [n -S]
MINTIER	EIIMNRT	MINTY, having flavor of mint (aromatic herb) [adj]
MOLDERS	DELMORS	MOLDER, to turn to dust by natural decay [v]
MOLDIER	DEILMOR	MOLDY, musty (having stale odor) [adj]
MONARDA	AADMNOR	aromatic herb [n -S]
MOULDER	DELMORU	to molder (to turn to dust by natural decay) [v -ED, -ING, -S]
MUSKIER	EIKMRSU	MUSKY, resembling musk (strongly odorous substance secreted by certain animals) [adj]
MUSKILY	IKLMSUY	in musky (resembling musk (strongly odorous substance secreted by certain animals)) manner [adv]
MUSTIER	EIMRSTU	MUSTY, having stale odor [adj]
MUSTILY	ILMSTUY	MUSTY, having stale odor [adv]
MYRRHIC	CHIMRRY	MYRRH, aromatic gum resin [adj]

ODORANT	ADNOORT	odorous substance [n -S]
ODORFUL	DFLOORU	ODOR, property of substance that affects sense of smell [adj]
ODORIZE	DEIOORZ	to make odorous [v -D, -ZING, -S]
ODOROUS	DOOORSU	having odor (property of substance that affects sense of smell) [adj]
OREGANO	AEGNOOR	aromatic herb used as seasoning [n -S]
ORIGANS	AGINORS	ORIGAN, marjoram (fragrant herb) [n]
OSMATIC	ACIMOST	depending mainly on sense of smell [adj]

PECKIER	CEEIKPR	PECKY, marked by decay caused by fungi [adj]
PERFUME	EEFMPRU	to fill with fragrant odor [v -D, -MING, -S]
PERFUMY	EFMPRUY	scented [adj]
PINESAP	AEINPPS	fragrant herb [n -S]
PONGIER	EGINOPR	PONGY, stinky (emitting foul odor) [adj]
PONGING	GGINNOP	PONG, to stink (to emit foul odor) [v]
PUNGENT	EGNNPTU	sharply affecting organs of taste or smell [adj]
PUNKIER	EIKNPRU	PUNKY, resembling punk (dry, decayed wood used as tinder) [adj]
PUTREFY	EFPRUY	to make or become putrid [v -FIED, -ING, -FIES]

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RANKEST	AEKNRST	RANK, strong and disagreeable in odor or taste [adj]
RECOILS	CEILORS	RECOIL, to draw back in fear or disgust [v]
REEKERS	EEEKRRS	REEKER, one that reeks (to give off strong, unpleasant odor) [n]
REEKING	EEGIKNR	REEK, to give off strong, unpleasant odor [v]

SALOOPS	ALOOPSS	SALOOP, hot drink made from infusion of aromatic herbs [n]
SAPROBE	ABEOPRS	organism that derives its nourishment from decaying organic matter [n -S]
SAVORED	ADEORSV	SAVOR, to taste or smell with pleasure [v]
SAVORER	AEORRSV	one that savors (to taste or smell with pleasure) [n -S]
SAVOURS	AORSSUV	SAVOUR, to savor (to taste or smell with pleasure) [v]
SAVOURY	AORSUVY	savory (pleasant to taste or smell) [adj -RIER, -RIEST]
SCENTED	CDEENST	SCENT, to fill with odor [v]
SCUNNER	CENNRSU	to feel loathing or disgust [v -ED, -ING, -S]
SHOCKED	CDEHKOS	SHOCK, to strike with great surprise, horror, or disgust [v]
SHOCKER	CEHKORS	one that shocks (to strike with great surprise, horror, or disgust) [n -S]
SMELLED	DEELLMS	SMELL, to perceive by means of olfactory nerves [v]
SMELLER	EELLMRS	one that smells (to perceive by means of olfactory nerves) [n -S]
SMELTED	DEELMST	SMELT, SMELL, to perceive by means of olfactory nerves [v]
SPALTED	ADELPST	denoting wood having irregular lines resulting from fungal decay [adj]
SPICERS	CEIPRSS	SPICER, one that spices (to season with spice (aromatic vegetable substance)) [n]
SPICING	CGIINPS	SPICE, to season with spice (aromatic vegetable substance) [v]
STENCHY	CEHNSTY	having stench (foul odor) [adj -HIER, -HIEST]
STINKER	EIKNRST	one that stinks (to emit foul odor) [n -S]
