SMELLIER	EEILLMRS	SMELLY, having unpleasant odor [adj]
SMELLING	EGILLMNS	SMELL, to perceive by means of olfactory nerves [v]
SMELTING	EGILMNST	SMELT, SMELL, to perceive by means of olfactory nerves [v]
STENCHES	CEEHNSST	STENCH, foul odor [n]
STINKBUG	BGIKNSTU	insect that emits foul odor [n -S]
STINKIER	EIIKNRST	STINKY, emitting foul odor [adj]
STINKING	GIIKNNST	STINK, to emit foul odor [v]
STINKPOT	IKNOPSTT	jar containing foul-smelling combustibles formerly used in warfare [n -S]
STORAXES	AEORSSTX	STORAX, fragrant resin [n]
STYRAXES	AERSSTXY	STYRAX, storax (fragrant resin) [n]
