SLIPOVER *EILOPRSV* pullover (garment that is put on by being drawn over head) [n -S]

OVERSPILL *EILLOPRSV* act or instance of spilling over [v -ED, -SPILT, -ING, S]
SPILOVER *EILLOPRSV* quantity that spills over [n -S]

OVERSWING *EGINORSVW* to swing to far [v -WUNG, -ING, -S]
WINGOVERS *EGINORSVW* **WINGOVER**, flight maneuver [n]

OVERTAKE *AEEKORTV* to catch up with [v -TOOK, -N, -KING, -S]
TAKEOVER *AEEKORTV* act of assuming control [n -S]

OVERTURN *ENORRTUV* to turn over [v -ED, -ING, -S]
TURNOVER *ENORRTUV* upset or overthrow [n -S]

OWNERSHIP *EHINOPRSW* state, relation, or fact of being owner [n -S]
