AACEILRT	a part of a millrace [n -S]
ADIIKLST	a support on which the tail of an airplane rests [n -S]
AIILNPST	to spin headlong down toward earth [v -NNED or -PUN, -NNING, -S]
AILNPSTU	to spin headlong down toward earth [v]
ADIILNTW	a wind coming from behind a moving vehicle [n -S]
AGIINNTT	to touch or affect slightly with something bad [v]

TAILSKID	ADIIKLST	a support on which the tail of an airplane rests [n TAILSKIDS]
TAILSPIN	AIILNPST	to spin headlong down toward earth [v TAILSPINNED or TAILSPUN, TAILSPINNING, TAILSPINS]
TAILSPUN	AILNPSTU	TAILSPIN, to spin headlong down toward earth [v]
TAILWIND	ADIILNTW	a wind coming from behind a moving vehicle [n TAILWINDS]
TAINTING	AGIINNTT	TAINT, to touch or affect slightly with something bad [v]
